The normal hands, however, face the player off against the dealer, whereby the player may choose to stake the Ante and play bets OR stake the Pair Plus hand according to the rank of that hand regardless of the cards in the dealer's hand. The game is played with a single deck of 52 cards, from which the dealer deals three cards dealt face-down to himself and three cards dealt face-up to the player, with an equal Ante bet placed on the play.

If the dealer does not have a qualifying Queens High hand or better, the Ante money is paid out evenly, and the play bets are returned. If the dealer's hand does qualify, win is determined by comparing the dealer's hand against the player's hand –whoever has the better hand wins. If the player does win, s/he is paid out even money on both the Ante AND the Play bets. As mentioned, the Pair Plus winning hand is paid out according to the pre-set Bonus payout table, irrespective of the strength of the Dealer's hand. The payout is fortified if the player chooses to fold his/her hand, even if the player's hand is a Pair or better. This modern, sophisticated game is smoothly and simply played, whilst the sharp, stream-lined graphics lend an air of classiness comparable to any land-based poker table, accessible from the comfort of your own home.

If the cards are the same, then they are named a pair, and a third card is then dealt into the middle space allocated for this purpose. If the card that is dealt is the same again, then you are paid out 11:1. If the card is not the same then the bet is pushed. If there is a gap between the two cards that are initially laid out then the Dealer indicates this amount by marking off this number in the Spread Row.

(The Spread is the number of cards (or ranks) that are between the two numbers). At this point, you can Raise or Call your bets. If you Raise, then you must place a bet equal to the first bet in the area marked Raise. If you Call then your original bet stands. The third card is now dealt. If the rank of the card falls between the two cards already on the table, then the winnings are paid out. If the third card is the same as one already dealt or outside of this range then you lose. This game requires a bit of skill, but is fun, exciting and offers some stunning rewards.
